1. **Apologies for absence** - None.

2. **Declarations of interest** - None.

3. **Public forum for questions**

No questions had been received from or were presented by members of the public.

7:41p.m. - Councillor J. Frith joined the meeting.

4. **Reports from external organisations**

(a) **Gawsworth & Chelford Wards Policing Team - Matters of interest / concern within the Parish** - It was reported that during September, 2021 the following incidents had been reported: suspicious activity at Salters Lane (all in order); branches in road at Salters Lane; possible drug driver near to Jodrell Bank; road traffic collisions at Salters Lane and Holmes Chapel Road and a noise complaint at Congleton Lane.

(b) **Cheshire East Ward Member Cllr. L. Smetham** - Borough Councillor L. Smetham reported that she was encouraging Parish Councils to remind residents of local roads which were being removed from the winter gritting routes. Lobbying groups are voicing their concerns to Cheshire East Council regarding reduced winter gritting and poor quality highway repairs. Average speed cameras are now operational on A536 at Eaton. All parishes are urged to submit views in respect of the Community Governance Review.

5. **Minutes**

(a) The Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 had been previously circulated to all Members. No objections to the accuracy of the Minutes were raised by Members.

## 8. Highway maintenance and enhancements

(a) **Cheshire East Council - Highways Top Up Scheme** - It was reported that the Highways Officer had advised that he does not recommend proceeding with the application as the likely cost of the proposed work would be excessive for the level of improvement which would be achieved thereby not offering good value for money to residents. He also suggested that this type of work would be better carried out in the spring when a greater impact and a longer term effect can be achieved. The Highways Officer had, however, offered to arrange for the road sweeper to attend Catchpenny Lane and Salters Lane to provide some tidying to these areas.

- vi. Protruding gully ironwork on Salters Lane (opposite junction with Leach Lane).

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[The problem you have reported is not causing an immediate safety issue, therefore, we will now look at the best long- term approach for this location.]

- vii. Flooding along A535 (in particular outside Farmwood View). [Highways have arranged a programme of work to make initial investigations and carry out follow up work to address issues along this stretch]
