Local Planning Applications

Since the last Newsletter, we have received over 20 planning applications to review. Applications have ranged from stables to major buildings at Jodrell Bank. The Parish Council has presented the view of the village based on limited input from villagers, we welcome all of your comments and will aim to put details of planning applications onto the website in 2018.
